As the largest Apprenticeship provider in the city and region, we have great links with employers. Around 800 employers are involved in our Apprenticeship programmes.

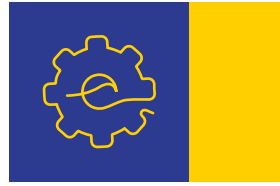
We know that our Apprentices understand well the knowledge, skills and behaviours they need to develop in order to contribute effectively within their job roles.

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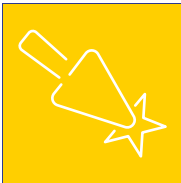
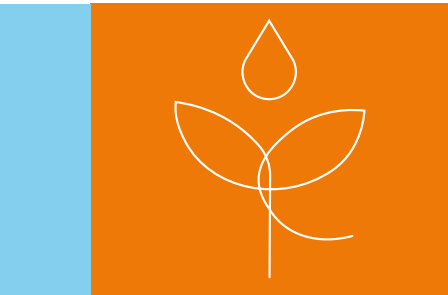
