This standard aims to give the Apprentice the knowledge, skills and behaviours to be able to complete welding tasks including at least one arc welding process, passing surface inspection. Welders work in a wide range of industries such as aerospace, structural engineering and construction.

Day-to-day tasks include studying blueprints and specifications, inspecting materials before welding, preparing metal components for welding and operating welding equipment.

These roles can be in a range of workshops including assembly yards, fabrication shops and construction sites.

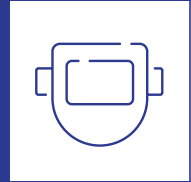
