This standard aims to give the Apprentice the knowledge, skills and behaviours to complete gas engineering tasks and duties. Day-to-day tasks include installing, commissioning, repairing and maintaining gas appliances safely and professionally. They would also need to complete work records and adhere to safety procedures.
